UCC Undergraduate Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to the University of the Commonwealth Caribbean's undergraduate programs students must submit the following:

- Proof of English language proficiency.
- Official Transcript of Exam Results of School Leaving Certificate and any Higher Education Certificate indicating all exams taken and grades earned. Passes must include Mathematics and English.

classes. Classes are taught through a combination of on-campus and field experiences. UCC also schedules 3-week, 3-month, 6-month ESL programs and can offer customized classes depending on demand and needs.

Jamaican Cultural Immersion Program

The UCC Cultural Immersion program is a 3 credit course, designed to deliver a unique learning experience to students based on their exposure to and participation in real world scenarios outside of their geographic comfort zone. It explores Jamaican culture (linguistic, political, economic, geographic, historical, artistic) through an intensive (on-campus) study and field experience in Jamaica over an exciting 2-week period. This gives the beneficiary a distinct competitive advantage among peers and competitors in today's competitive global community.

Pre-Med, Pre-Dental & Medical Doctoral Programs

UCC recently partnered with the Caribbean School of Medical Sciences, Jamaica (CSMSJ) to offer the Pre-Med, Pre-Dental and Medical Doctoral Programs. The Pre-med and Pre-dental programs are 16 months in duration and culminate in a diploma in Pre-medical sciences. These students will be able to do the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) and can apply for General Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Sciences. The Medical Doctoral Program is a twelve (12) semester (4 yr) study that includes Basic Sciences and Clinical Rotations in Hospitals and Primary Health Care Facilities in Jamaica, Cuba, the Caribbean, as well as in the United States.

- 1. A bachelor's degree from an accredited university or equivalent
- 2. A minimum GPA of 2.5 in last 60 units or credits earned
- 3. Passes in UCC Proficiency Tests

English Language Proficiency Requirement for UCC programs

Students who have successfully completed level 5 of UCC's English as a

Second Language program are not required to have IELTS or TOEFL scores to matriculate to UCC degrees. A pass in English equivalent to O' Level (Grade A-C) is also acceptable.
