

Sagicor Foundation Scholarship Programme

The Scholarship programme, Sagicor Scholar, offers \$250,000 in tuition support

Students applying to be a *Sagicor Scholar* must be fulltime students, with a GPA of 3.0 and above, and demonstrate the need for financial assistance.

Eligibility:

- All Sagicor Foundation Scholarship recipients will be required to give at least 20 hours of voluntary service to the Sagicor Foundation activities.
- Students applying must be accepted to pursue fulltime studies and have a GPA of 3.0 and above.
- Applicants must demonstrate the need for financial assistance.
- Only clients of Sagicor Group Jamaica and its subsidiaries are eligible. Students whose parents are clients will be considered. Team members of Sagicor Group Jamaica are <u>not</u> eligible to apply, instead, Sagicor team members may apply for the Sagicor Foundation Internal Scholarship Plan.
- Scholarships offered are applicable to tuition fees and paid directly to the recipient's institution.

Carreras' Post Graduate Scholarship

Criteria for Application for Carreras' Post Graduate Scholarship

Carreras Scholarship are valued at JA\$1,800,000. This Carreras scholarship is tenable at any recognized university worldwide and can be applied to any field of study. Applicant must provide:

- One copy (certified) of your official academic transcript, showing academic background (at least an Upper Second Class degree or equivalent at the time of application) and Extra-Curricular activities at university level
- Statement of purpose of study
- Evidence of acceptance for postgraduate studies at a college/university
- Statement of intention of candidate after course completion
- One copy (certified) of your birth certificate or other document showing evidence of age and nationality (Passport or Driver's Licence)

- One copy of your resume
- Two letters of reference

*Only shortlisted candidates will be interviewed.

The successful applicant will be required to give an undertaking to work in Jamaica for at least three (3) years immediately following completion of the course of study.

- Be an enrolled student in any of the institutions noted
- Produce application letter, completed application form and two references (academic & character)
- Official Transcript
- Be in need of financial assistance
- Have achieved at least a 'B' average (GPA of 3.0) in the previous academic year **Only shortlisted candidates will be interviewed.*

- Completed Application form
- An application letter
- One copy (certified) of your official academic transcript, with at least a 'B' average (GPA of 3.0) in the previous academic year
- Be in need of financial assistance
- Two (academic & character) references

*Only shortlisted candidates will be interviewed.

Scholarships are tenable at any locally recognised university and can be applied to any field of study.

- Applicant must maintain a GPA of 3.50.
- Two (2) written references must be submitted to verify applicant's involvement in projects.
- Submission of transcript.

Note: Transcripts should be submitted to outline GPA

Applicants are required to have a minimum "B" average and who are financially challenged. The Foundation opens the application in the month of May each year.
