All graduates are required to be at the National Arena by 9:00 a.m.

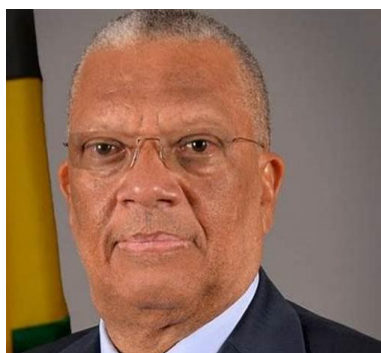
All guests must be seated by 10:00 a.m.

Doctoral Awardee



Dr. Nigel Clarke, DPhil., currently Deputy Managing Director at the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and former Minister of Finance and the Public Service (2018–2024), will receive the **Honorary Doctor of Finance (D.Fin. Honoris Causa)**. A Rhodes Scholar and Oxford-trained economist, Dr. Clarke has emerged as one of the most influential financial strategists in the Caribbean. Under his stewardship, Jamaica's economic policy framework gained international recognition, attracting foreign investment and setting new benchmarks for economic resilience.

Doctoral Awardee



Dr. Peter Phillips, MP, former Minister of Finance and Planning, will be awarded the **Honorary Doctor of Economics (D.Econ. Honoris Causa)**. Widely regarded as one of the chief architects of Jamaica's fiscal reform, Dr. Phillips is celebrated for his pivotal leadership between 2012 and 2016, during which he negotiated a landmark IMF agreement that restored international financial credibility and led Jamaica out of economic crisis. His legacy is marked by prudent policy-making, a commitment to inclusive development, and tireless efforts to stabilize the national economy and reduce public debt.

- ☐ You **must** complete your graduation application by the deadline of 4:00 pm on Friday, July 11, 2025.
- ☐ You **must** book your place by the deadline, even if the publication of final grades is delayed.
- ☐ Any outstanding debt to the University **must** be cleared.
- ☐ Five (5) graduation invitations each will be provided in the week leading up to your ceremony.

- ☐ You are required to be at the arena by 9:00 a.m. on July 20, 2025. Guests are required to be seated by 10:00 a.m.
