How is the new integrated MICON/C4C Learning Management System (LMS) portal different from the existing Zoom/Moodle platform?

The new integrated MICON/C4C portal will be more functional and much improved. However, we are not transitioning entirely to a new LMS platform – instead, we are **expanding and building** on the existing LMS platform. Therefore, current students will continue to use the Zoom videoconferencing and the Moodle LMS platforms as well as the AERION SMS. Most undergraduate courses, however, will now be taught by UCC international online faculty, via pre-recorded video based lectures, from top international universities. Some courses, where required, will continue to be delivered as tutorial sessions by local faculty via Zoom and Moodle. The new expanded/integrated portal will also now provide powerful learning analytics to track students' learning progress and mastery of required competencies and skills. Can I continue to work as I complete my UCC degree?

Yes, the large majority of students at UCC, work full-time or part-time while attending the University. However, remember the need to balance school with work and your personal life when determining how many courses to take each semester.

If I am a former or returning UCC student, do I have to go through the application process again? Who do I contact?

Any former or returning UCC student should contact UCC advising at advisement@ucc.edu.jm to review programme requirements and receive help walking through the re-admission process.

How long will it take to get a UCC degree?

The time it takes to complete a UCC degree depends on how many hours you need to satisfy the degree requirements, the number of hours you take each semester, and your academic performance. Typically, students take between 9 and 12 hours each week and complete their degree within 4 years. Some students take longer, while others finish faster.

How many credit hours am I required to take at the UCC?

In general, a Bachelor of Science degree programme ranges from 120 to 127 credit hours. A student may gain advanced standing for up to 50% of the total credit hours, if an appropriate Associate of Science degree or equivalent is already earned, and can complete the Bachelor of Science degree programme in two years.

What is the approximate cost for each module during the summer 2020?

Undergraduate students, therefore, will now pay tuition <u>starting at</u> ONLY J\$15,000 or US\$112 per module for selected modules! Tuition/credit will vary for the summer depending on your course/the number of modules registered for and will range between **J\$15,000** - **\$24,000** (J\$5,000/credit - \$8,000/credit x 3 credits) – See tuition scale below. Once enrolled, you will have 24/7 hour access to playback these high impact recorded UCC video lectures at any time.

How do I access my degree program on this new and improved, integrated MICON/C4C Learning Management System (LMS)?

Once you have paid your initial tuition, you will be given 24/7 access to the course on the MICON/C4C portal and to an orientation module ahead of the study session.

If I have already paid my tuition or a part thereof for the summer, based on last semester's tuition of \$30,000/module, will I be refunded any portion based on the current "up to 50% tuition waiver" special summer incentive program?

Yes. Under UCC's Refund Policy, students are entitled to a full refund of tuition paid until the end of Normal Registration. Once that period has passed, students may register for additional modules or apply the difference as a credit towards next semester's tuition.

If I had already received a tuition waiver, will I be eligible for another waiver of up to 50% for the summer?

No.
