## 2026 – 2027 FEES

Prospective students are required to pay both **UOL** and **UCC** fees and will have 3-6 years to complete the **Bachelor of Laws** Degree programme. **EXAMPLE (Graduate Route): Annual tuition fees for both UOL and UCC: £2537 (Rate used J\$214 to £1) = J\$542,918.00 + J\$308,100.00 = J\$851,018.00.**

**Initial Registration fee:** This fee is a **one-time fee** paid at commencement of the programme and as such, along with the non-refundable application fee, is paid in the first year only.

**UOL Payment Options:** All UOL fee payments are payable directly to the University of London either **online** using Visa or MasterCard or **off-line** via Western Union Quick Pay.

Full UCC's fees are required upon acceptance of the offer payable prior to class commencement. A **Non-Refundable Commitment Fee of \$10,000.00 along with Annual Miscellaneous fee of \$15,750.00 (i.e \$25,750.00)** is required for part payment or for Students Loan Bureau applicants, along with a commitment letter for balance of payment. The Commitment fee payment will be applied to your tuition fee upon full registration and will confirm your space in the programme.

**UCC Payment Options:** Tuition fee payments can be made using debit card, credit card, manager's cheque, Aeorion Student Management System or via bank using student ID number and must be paid in full prior to commencement of classes. The Student Financial Services Department will assist here.

**NOTE:** No cash transactions are allowed at the UCC Campuses. All Application fees are non-refundable and all fees are subject to change at short notice. All relevant fees must be paid prior to UCC's Orientation and class commencement.

**Second and Third Year Continuation fee:** A continuation fee of US\$27 is paid annually by returning students to proceed to the next academic year of the programme.

### STUDENT LOAN

Applicants may apply for student loan at the Students' Loan Bureau or at any local financial institution.

### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application for admission to the University of London (UOL) programme requires that all qualifications be certified. Please present original certificate(s) showing the final awards for each qualification and photocopies of these originals, along with other documents at the University of the Commonwealth Caribbean (UCC). Documents for certification and submission to UCC are:

- Two passport sized photographs
- UCC Application Form for UOL (Apply Online)
- Academic Certificates
- Official transcript(s) from every college/tertiary institution/university attended
- Non-refundable UCC Application fee (see above) [Pay online or at Cashier]

### Documentary Evidence:

Attach a photocopy of **one** of the following as proof of your full name (including any change of name) and date of birth to your application:

- Birth certificate or Passport
- Marriage certificate
- Deed poll
- Statutory declaration
- Alien's registration certificate

UCC will scan the certified documents and send them to you via email. Please note that you must obtain a **Validation Code** from UCC to apply to the UOL online application. Kindly respond to the email sent to you providing your certified documents and request your **Validation Code**. Please then visit UOL at: [www.londoninternational.ac.uk](http://www.londoninternational.ac.uk) to apply online and upload the certified documents. At the end of this online application process you are required to pay the relevant UOL application fee (£65 as per above).

**UOL Registration:** The University of London will make direct contact with students to provide username and password for entry onto the UOL platform. Students will obtain their UOL Acceptance Letter with

their Student Registration Number (SRN) and given instruction procedures to register for the relevant UOL modules. Please take note to follow those online instructions carefully.

**Important Next Steps:** At this stage you are required to:

- Email your University of London's Acceptance Letter to UCC
- Visit the UOL website to pay UOL Registration and Module fees as per above
- Pay UCC's tuition fee utilising one of the payment options available
- Attend UCC Orientation as per date in UCC's Acceptance Letter
- Take note of UCC class schedule available in your Acceptance Package
- Pay careful attention to key dates and stipulated deadlines and act accordingly.

#### KEY DATES

The UOL academic year runs from 1 November to 31 October. There are two application and registration deadlines each year for entry at the start of the academic year (September -**Fall**) and for entry mid-way through the academic year (May -**Summer**). However, the University of the Commonwealth Caribbean enrol students for September (**Fall**) each year only.

**UOL Assessments/Examinations:** Students sit UOL Assessments May/June and October each year.

**UCC Assessments/Examinations:** Mock Assessments are done in December and April in preparation for the UOL Assessments, which is mandatory for all students within the programme.

**Early Application [FALL]:** Please apply by **July 31** to ensure early application and registration to allow for study materials to be sent to you prior to class commencement in September.

**UCC Payment Plans:** A Payment plan is available on UCC's portion only. Fifty percent (50%) deposit is required prior to commencement of the programme. The fifty percent (50%) balance will attract Finance Charges of seven percent (7%).

**Late Registration Payment:** Registration payments must be completed by the registration deadline otherwise late fees will be incurred of \$3,500.00.

#### REGISTRATION FOR RETURNING STUDENTS ONLY:

**NORMAL:** Normal or regular Registration ends August 31.

**LATE:** Late Registration begins September 1 and ends September 30 and will attract late fees.

**Course Withdrawal/Postponement:** UCC reserves the right to cancel/postpone a scheduled course if it is undersubscribed. In this event, UCC will refund all tuition fees already paid for the cancelled course.
